# <u>Treasurer's Report – Jeff Idels</u>

- The Treasurer's Report was reviewed and the following was highlighted:
  - Rebecca Blair paid \$100 to the Dennis Memorial Library to secure our meeting space for 2023, and treated it as her donation to Hearts and Paws. Thank you, Rebecca.
  - \$293 was raised at the Harwich Christmas Stroll for the Family Food Pantry.
  - \$150 in new member dues were received.
  - \$10 in donations through "Amazon Smile" were recorded.

#### **Events**

- Harwich Christmas Stroll Our second year there was a lot of fun. We were stationed right next to Santa, so we met with tons of kids and their parents, and raised \$293 for the Family Food Pantry. There were some logistical issues with the Chamber of Commerce, so we will not be involved with the Christmas tree judging contest next year.
- The **Lily House** fundraiser has been postponed, as Home Depot has halted gatherings due to the spike in COVID. We will try to find an opportunity in 2023 to raise funds. Lily House still wants to do a photo shoot on their premises which we can both use to raise awareness for our causes.

- Amy "rolled out" the spreadsheet of scheduled visits, including the Dennis Senior Center, Rock Harbor Respite, Brewster Council on Aging, Cape Regency, Veterans Group Home in Dennis and the Falmouth Elementary schools. This schedule will be made available to everyone.

- Amy also reported that some of the venues have three teams of handlers and dogs signed up, which is very exciting.
