- 2. Laird Anthony from Rock Harbor Respite gave us his feelings on what Hearts & Paws visits meant to his clients:
  - a. A 30 minute+ session worked well because some of the clients became anxious if an event was too long
  - b. Many days there was a lot of agitation with the clients in the afternoon before the dogs arrived but he could clearly see the behaviors change when the dogs arrived
  - c. As handlers react with clients, they need to have patience and recognize cues from the clients. This interaction is very important too.
  - d. Clients liked to tell stories of their past dogs
  - e. There is one more activity after the dogs leave and he feels that the clients are much more engaged on those days.
  - f. Laird enjoyed the visits with the dogs almost more than anyone else !!
